THEORY TRAINING

H001 – HETAS Introduction to Solid Fuel Course – one day

This course is a basic introduction to solid fuel installations and regulations. This course is targeted at the candidate who has no prior knowledge of heating or plumbing.

H002 – HETAS Solid Fuel Regulations and Standards Course – two days

This theory course is designed for retail staff, surveyors, construction professionals, building control bodies and architects looking to gain knowledge on legislation, design and specification of solid fuel installations. This will enable them to carry out home surveys and make an accurate assessment of their requirements. Successful completion of the course can lead to registration as a HETAS Approved Retailer.

INSTALLER TRAINING

H003 – HETAS Dry Appliance Installer Course (practically assessed) – three days

This course is targeted at candidates who have appropriate experience. Candidates are required to have practical working experience in the construction/heating industry. The course will provide the candidate with training to install a dry appliance and includes theory and practical assessment. Successful completion provides a pathway to HETAS registration on the competent persons scheme for the installation of dry appliances. (Please note there are certain pre-requisites to attending this course)

H004 – HETAS Wet Appliance Installer Course (practically assessed) – one day

This course is targeted at candidates who have appropriate plumbing/heating work experience and have already completed the H003 course. The course will provide the candidate with training to install a wet appliance and includes theory and practical assessment. Successful completion provides a pathway to HETAS registration on the competent persons scheme for the installation of wet appliances. (Please note there are certain pre-requisites to attending this course)

H005 – HETAS Biomass Course - four days

Because of the increasing complexity of biomass appliances & heating systems, HETAS has introduced a dedicated biomass training course to meet demand from installers. The course covers appliances up to 45kW intentionally but the training may be appropriate for the installation of appliances up to 100kW, including woodburning stoves, log boilers, pellet appliances & chip boilers.

The course is a mix of theory and practical elements. It enables installers to carry out feasibility studies, and to professionally advise the client on fuel type, storage options & system design. It also covers marketing and the various grants available for biomass systems.

Successful completion of the biomass course allows HETAS registrants to extend their registration categories to include installation of wood pellet stoves or other mechanically fed biomass appliances. The biomass course will also provide evidence of the competence requirements to meet MCS biomass installer standards. Please note that those who have not undertaken the H003 and H004 courses may be required to undertake the H005 BR course which is an additional day of training on regulations and legislation. This course allows limited scope registration with HETAS.
