SOLID FUEL, WOOD AND BIOMASS INSTALLATIONS

The growth of the renewable energy sector has meant increasing demand for solid fuel, wood and biomass installations.

In England and Wales, there are two routes to legally install a domestic solid fuel, wood or biomass burning appliance.

HETAS registered installers can self-certify that their work complies with the relevant building regulations, and issue the customer with a certificate of compliance. A copy of the certificate is also sent to HETAS who will notify the relevant Local Authority on their behalf.

Alternatively, the customer must apply to the local authority building control department for a building notice, and pay the appropriate inspection fee which can cost up to £300 per job.

Business annual registration fee	£160.00 plus VAT
Registered engineer annual fee	£45.00 plus VAT



Scotland:

Business application fee including inspection	£285.00 plus VAT
Business annual registration fee	£260.00 plus VAT
Registered engineer annual fee	£45.00 plus VAT
