

HETAS TRAINING



HETAS registrants can self certify that their work complies with the relevant building regulations, and use the HETAS works notification system to issue the customer with a certificate of compliance.

To become HETAS registered, applicants must successfully complete the relevant training for the type of work they wish to undertake. They will also need to have proven experience of working with solid fuel appliances.

HETAS installer training courses are aimed at people who already have some practical experience of working in the plumbing and heating industry.

HETAS training courses are designed to cover safe, efficient and reliable appliance installation in accordance with the relevant regulations. They are suitable for installers, service engineers, chimney sweeps, specifiers and building control officers.

INSTALLER TRAINING

H003 – HETAS Dry Appliance Installer Course (practically assessed) – three days

This course is targeted to candidates who have relevant work experience. They should have a knowledge and understanding of building regulations and working experience in the construction/heating industry. This will include both theory and practical assessment. Successful completion leads to certification that can be used for registration on the competent persons registration scheme for the installation of dry appliances. (Please note there are certain pre-requisites to attending this course.)

H004 – HETAS Wet Appliance Installer Course (practically assessed) – one day

This course is targeted to candidates who have relevant plumbing/heating work experience and have already completed the H003 course. This will include both theory and practical assessment. Successful completion leads to certification that can be used for registration on the competent persons registration scheme for the installation of wet appliances. (Please note there are certain pre-requisites to attending this course).

OTHER TRAINING

H001 – HETAS Introduction to Solid Fuel Course – one day

This course is a basic introduction to solid fuel installations and regulations. This course is targeted at the candidate who has no prior knowledge of heating or plumbing.

H002 – HETAS Solid Fuel Regulations and Standards Course – two days

This theory awareness course is designed to introduce candidates to the processes of solid fuel installations and is targeted at show room staff, surveyors, building control officers and architects who need updates on regulations. This includes a theory assessment and certificate which can lead to a listing on the HETAS Approved Retailer scheme which HETAS hopes to introduce in the near future.



H005 – HETAS BIOMASS COURSE

Because of the increasing complexity of biomass appliances and heating systems, HETAS has also introduced a dedicated biomass training course to meet demand from installers. The course covers appliances up to 100kw, including woodburning stoves, log boilers, pellet appliances and chip boilers.

The course is a mix of theory and practical elements. It enables installers to carry out feasibility studies, and to professionally advise the client on fuel type, storage options and system design. It also covers marketing and the various grants available for biomass systems.

Course delegates must have already successfully completed the H003 and H004 courses and a Part G unvented hot water course.

Successful completion of the biomass course allows HETAS registrants to extend their registration categories to include installation of wood pellet stoves or other mechanically fed biomass appliances.
